John 3:16 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:38-39</p>	<p>2.To grow in love and purity This is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ. Philippians 1: 9-11</p>
<p>3.To grow in thankfulness In everything give thanks: for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks to the Lord for he is good. His love endures forever. 1 Chronicles 16:34</p>	<p>4.To grow in trust of God Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not depend on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths. Prov3: 6 You will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. Isaiah 26: 3</p>
<p>5.To grow in forgiveness If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1: 9 Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Colossians 3: 13</p>	<p>6.To grow in kindness Clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive. Colossians 3: 12-13 Love is kind. 1 Corinthians 13:4</p>
<p>7.To grow in understanding their destiny I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Jeremiah 29: 11</p>	<p>8.To grow in good works For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works which God prepared in advance for us to do. Eph 2: 10</p>
<p>9.To grow in gentleness A gentle answer turns away anger, but a harsh word stirs it up. Proverbs 15: 1 A quick-tempered person does foolish things. Proverbs 14: 17 Let your gentleness be evident to all. Philippians 4:5</p>	<p>10.To grow as a witness to Jesus Go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. Matt. 28:19-20 The Holy Spirit will come upon you. ... You will be my witnesses in every part of the world. Acts 1: 7-8</p>

To grow as a worshipper of God I will sing of the love of the Lord forever; I will make your faithfulness known through all generations. I will declare that your love stands firm for ever. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. Mark 10:43-44</p>
<p>19.To grow in love for people Love one another as I have loved you. John 15:12 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Ephesians 4:2 Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:8</p>	<p>20.To grow in prayerfulness The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. James 5: 16 Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances. 1Thessalonians 5:16-17 The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer. 1 Peter 3:12</p>

To grow in confidence of heaven Do not let your hearts be troubled..... In my Father's house are many rooms.... I am going there to prepare a place for you. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith. 1 Peter 5: 9 Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one. Matthew 6:13 God is faithful: he will provide a way of escape. 1 Corinthians 10: 13</p>

Isaiah 41:10 Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.
