Finding a way for my heart to respond With a parent or sibling make a small asault course or maze. Then use a scarf to blindfold yourself and then take it in turns to try and get through it. Next try and instruct each other through it. Which was easier? Why were the instructions helpful?

Read about Thomas meeting Jesus in a bible at home. (John 20:24-29) Why didn't Thomas beleive Jesus had been raised? What helped him beleive?

Can I see Jesus? Just because I can't see Jesus with my eyes does that mean I can't beleive he is real? How do I know Jesus is real? How can I 'see' Jesus at work in my life?

In today's readings John says that he has written all that he saw Jesus do so others might believe. How about today you write or draw a small book or a poster to show reasons why you beleive in Jesus. You could even but these Good News messages somewhere people can see them so that they might beleive in Jesus also.
